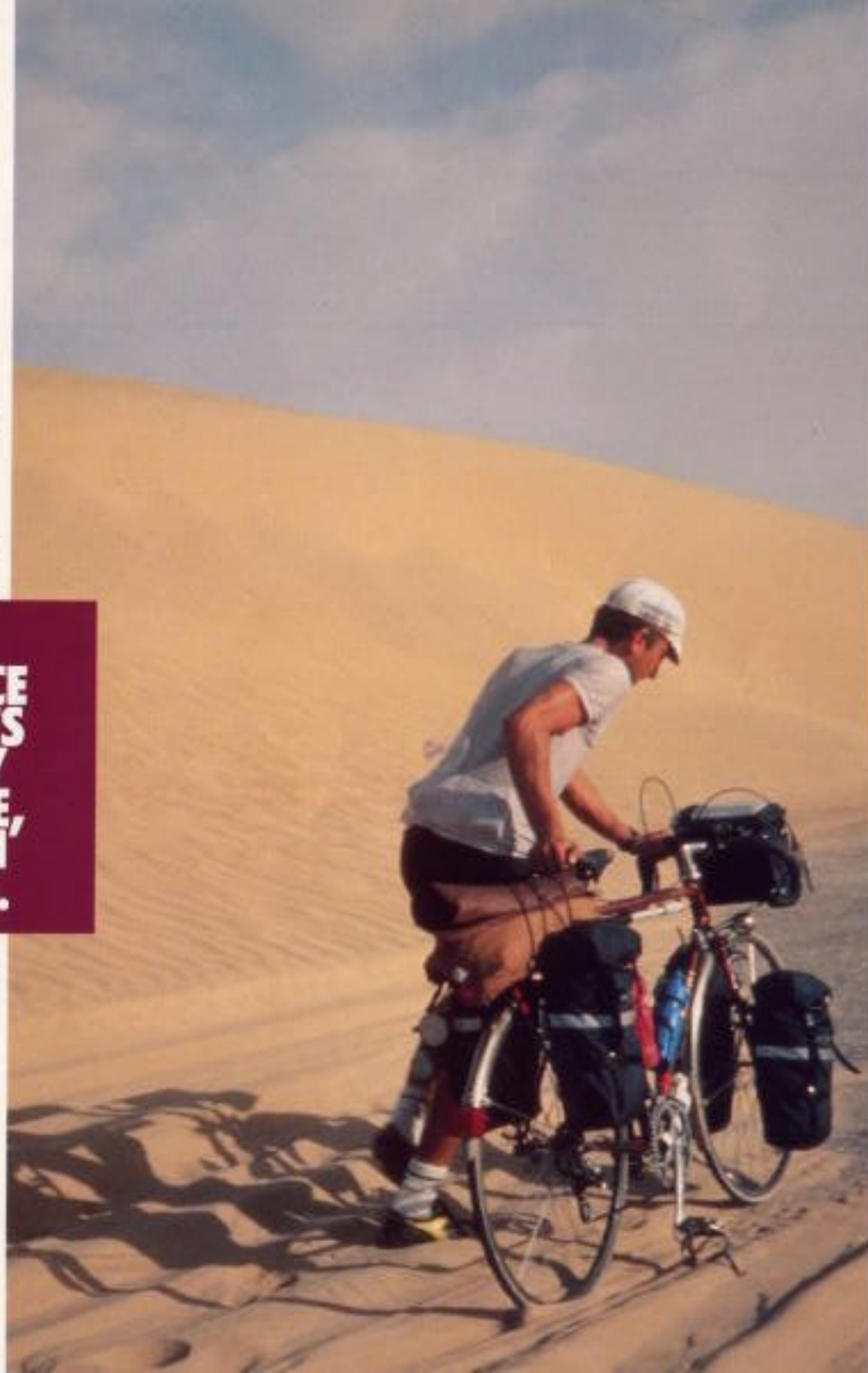
created a machine that could be counted on to swallow up long lengths of road with silent efficiency.

As is now customary, Trek's dedicated touring bicycles utilize an unparalleled long-wheelbase geometry. But for 1985, all are built with investment-cast

frame members that allow Treks to undergo greater stress than those bikes without this revolutionary technology.

To crown this achievement, each long-distance Trek is adorned with serious touring componentry like Shimano XT cantilever brakes, sealed Maillard Helicomatic hubs (that quickly let you customize gearing to suit the terrain), Huret's acclaimed Duopar derailleur system, and a host of braze-ons including 3 bottle mounts and Blackburn's best racks.

So before you head off on your next tour, head over to your nearby Trek dealer and discover just how much further a bicycle can go.

There's no mistaking this bicycle, with its extended wheelbase. It was born to tour. Outfitted with long-range componentry to let it do just that—including a sealed Maillard Helicomatic hub for easy freewheel changes, Huret Duopar derailleurs for quick 15-speed shifting, and Shimano's XT cantilever brakes for sure stopping under a full load. And the full complement of braze-ons (including Blackburn front low-rider mounts) lets you stow your gear with ease.

In one year, the 720 has undoubtedly logged more miles than any other production touring bike. The reason is simple—a long and lean frame geometry composed entirely of Reynolds 531 tubing and Trek's own investment-cast fittings. Plus a wide-ranging Huret Titanium Duopar derailleur system linked to a 48/44/28 triple crankset. A sealed 700 Series Helicomatic hub with quick-release free-wheel. Puncture-resistant Kevlar-belted radial tires. Color-coordinated Blackburn racks. And all the braze-ons the serious tourist could ask for on a single machine.

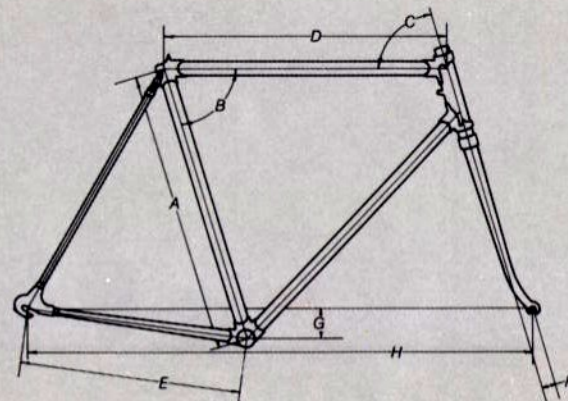
