

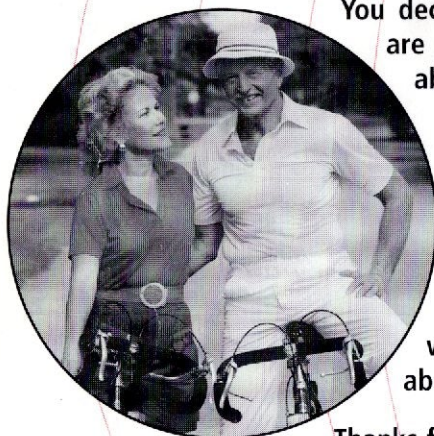

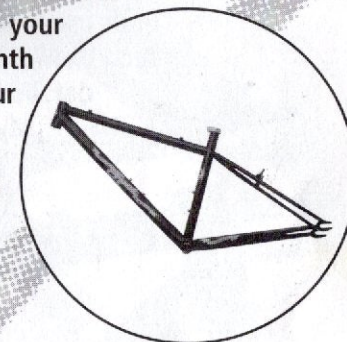

- Powder coated metallic red, matte black or deep blue

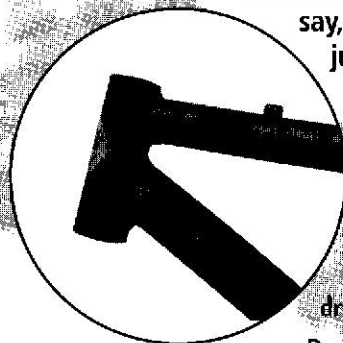

Our titanium frame is built using aircraft grade 3-2.5 tubing from Anco-Tech and features the same precision building and details as the steel frames. What more can we say, excess doesn't need to be justified, just enjoyed.



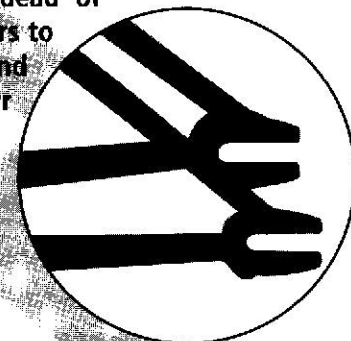

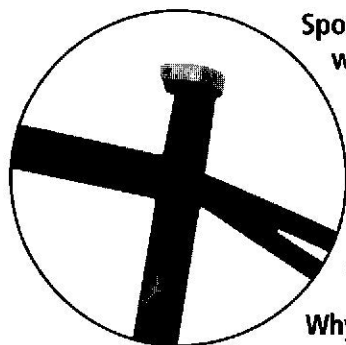

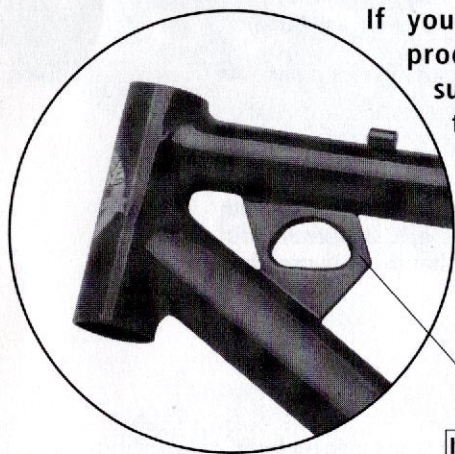


Warranty
